next and then Arwell & y^e remaining lot for my said Daughter at which four lots I give unto them as aforesaid
as their heirs for ever in my will and Desire is that my wife make & dispose of y^e plantation in
Norfolk that was her fathers as she shall see best & most advantage with y^e advice of her uncles Mr. Richard
and Charles Sayer & further as to y^e Lot & houseing given my wife, my will & Desire is that she shall peace-
ably & quietly enjoy it only during her natural life & no other wife
I make & ordain my said wife Elizabeth Mosley my Exor & of this my will & request Mr. Charles Sayer & Mr. Hilkey
Mosley friendly advise to my wife in y^e ordering bringing up or placing out my Children as they think best
for their serving & hoping my wife will readily take their advice in w^{ch} respect confirmation to all above
