I give and bequeath all that Tract of Land that I bought of Isaac White his two Daughters to be equally divided between the said Daughters the Wives of my first to Sarah and the Easternmost part to Eliza to them & their Heirs for ever I give all the Remainder of my Estate of what Nature or Quality so ever to be equally divided between my loving Wife Anne Ellgood & her four Children to them and their Heirs for ever. *Witness my hand*
 my loving Wife Anne Ellgood and my Son in Law William Nicholson to be whole
 sole Executors of this my Last Will and Testament in Witness whereof I
 have set my hand and Seal this 22nd day of March 1753

In the Name of God Amen I James Nimmo Son of Prince
 Ann County in King's County Ireland I give the use and Service
 of my Negroes Windows Ann, Hope, Sarah, Dianah, Cherry, and Eliza
 to my loving Wife Mary Nimmo during her Natural Life Except as hereafter
 Excepted Item I give and bequeath to my Son William Nimmo my Negro
 Bobb Harry and Jane to him and his heirs for ever Item I give and bequeath
 to my Son George Nimmo my Negroes little moody, Agall, Ravinah
 to him and his Heirs for ever Likewise I give to my said Son George
 Nimmo all that Tract and Plantation of Land I bought of J^r Lenthrop
 to him and his Heirs for ever. Item I give to my said Son Jacob Nimmo all
 my Land and Marsh at Kewmye Creek to him and his heirs for ever. Not-
 withstanding which said Gift. It is my Will and Desire that my said
 son Jacob shall not hinder my son James Nimmo from carrying his
 Stock of Cattle to the said Marshes if he likes so to do. Item I give and be-
 queath to my son James Nimmo my Negroes Kate, Great Muddy & pleasant
 to him and his heirs for ever to be immediately in possession of them after
 my Decease Likewise give to my said Son James Nimmo all my Lots
 or pieces of Lotts in Newtown to him and his heirs for ever Item I give &
 bequeath to my Daughter Janet Nimmo my Negroes Hannah, Jack and
 Molly to her and her heirs for ever. Item I give and Desire to be equally

decided between all my Children after my Wife's Death all the Negroes which I
 said Wife has the life of for life together with all other my Negroes not before devised
 in this my Last Will (my Sons W^m Cushern and James to Allow what they have
 already given them to make the rest of my Children equal with them) to them
 and their heirs for ever. And further, it is my Will and Desire that all my House-
 hold Goods &c. together with all my Stock of Cattle Sheep Horses and Hogs to be
 equally divided between my Loving Wife Mary and all my Children to them &
 their heirs for ever. Lastly I Nominate and Appoint my two Sons W^m and
 James Nimmie my whole & sole Executors of this my Last Will and Testament
 revoking all other Wills by me heretofore made In Witness Whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand & Seal the 19th March 1753

Hunter Will

In the Name of God Amen I John Hunter, Son of Principals Anne County
 being very sick and weak of Body &c. I give to my loving Wife, I am married
 Hunter the use of all my Lands Plantation and Houses thereon for and during
 her Natural Life not to be disturbed therein by any person whatsoever. I give
 and bequeath to my Son Jacob Hunter the Plantation wherein I now live
 with all the Lands thereunto belonging to him & his heirs for ever only reser-
 ving the use thereof to my loving Wife as above. I give and bequeath to my Dau-
 ghter Margaret Harper One Negro Girl named Sue (being now in her
 possession) to her and her heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to my Daughter
 Mary Cartwright One Negro Girl named Jane being now in her possession
 to her and her heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to my Daughter James Hunter
 One Negro Girl named Sarah to her and her heirs for ever. I give and be-
 queath to my Son John Hunter One Negro Boy named Bobb to him and
 his heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to my Son Tho^s Hunter one Negro
 Boy named George to him & his heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to my
 Son James Hunter One Negro Boy named Samuel to him and his
 heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Elizabeth Hunter one
 Negro Boy named Mingo to her and her heirs for ever. I give and bequeath
 to my Daughter Fanny Hunter One Negro Girl named Sue to her and
 her heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to my Daughter Joyce Hunter One Negro
 Boy named Moses to her and her heirs for ever. I give to my Loving Wife for
 and during the use and Labour of the following Negroes (to wit) Phillis
 Mazy Rachel Sarah Robin beaver & Borden together with the use of all my Tools
 not Existed of what kind or Nature was ever during her Natural Life for
 bringing up my Children with all & after her decease I give the said Negroes.
