do assign & sell & forever assign & make over unto the said Cap^t John Hutchings his heirs & assigns
Adm^r & assigns all & singular the goods chattels & effects particularly mentioned in the like
schedule & inventory above written with all the late rights, Tithes, Interest claim & demand what
soever of one the said Samuel Hollowell my heirs & assigns or of any of them to the same or any
part thereof To have and To hold all & singular the goods chattels & effects aforesaid un-
to the said Cap^t John Hutchings his heirs & assigns Adm^r & assigns, to the only proper Use & Be-
nefit of the said Cap^t John Hutchings by his acceptance hereof that in case the
said Sam^l Hollowell his heirs & assigns Adm^r & assigns shall well & truly pay unto & secure
the said Cap^t John Hutchings his heirs & assigns the aforesaid sum of thirteen
pounds eighteen shill^g & eight pence half penny current money aforesaid with all charges
thereon at or before the first day of October next ensuing the date hereof then & from
thence forth these presents & every Clause therein to be void & Null any thing herein
to the contrary notwithstanding. It is further Agreed that the particulars shall be
main & be in the possession of the said Samuel Hollowell provided he does not once
do nor abuse them, & the said Samuel Hollowell for himself his heirs & assigns
doth Covenant & grant to & with the said Cap^t John Hutchings his heirs & assigns
Adm^r that he the said Sam^l Hollowell & his heirs & assigns shall well & truly pay &
Content the said sum of thirteen pounds eighteen shill^g & eight pence half penny and
charges according to the proviso aforesaid, & that in case the said Sam^l Hollowell
shall make default in performance of the proviso aforesaid or misuse or abuse the
goods aforesaid or any part thereof that then & immediately thereafter the said
Cap^t John Hutchings his heirs & assigns Adm^r or assigns shall & may Lawfully take
sell & dispose of all & singular the particulars aforesaid to the highest bidder or
Bidders by way of public sale & pay & retain to himself the said sum of thirteen
pounds eighteen shill^g & eight pence half penny & anything & other mon^y repaying the
