 this my last will & Testament in manner & form following (that is to say) first & principally I
 commend my Soul to almighty God my Creator assuredly believing that I shall receive full
 pardon of all my sins & be saved by 4th precious death & merits of my blessed Saviour & redome:
 in Jesus Christ, & my body to 4th earth from whence it was taken to be buried in such decent
 Christian manner as my Ex^{or} hereafter named shall think fit as touching such worldly Estate
 as 4th Lord in his mercy hath bestowed upon me my will & meaning is 4th said shall be bestowed
 as hereafter by this my will is expressed, & first I do revoke & frustrate & make void all will
 or wills by me formerly made & appoint this my last will & Testament I do give &
 bequeath unto my Son Cason Moors all 4th land & plantation with or on I now live unto him
 and his heirs for ever & two negroes named Jemmy & Nancy & also one negro man named Tom
 one black boy named flea & also other horses & man that are branded for him already to be
 to him immediately after my decease & not to be disposed with, said negroes until he shall
 attain to 4th age of eighteen years & also that he shall have 4th privilege of building upon
 4th said land a place called building in 4th said land & that of 4th or had house making &
 his mother during her natural life from working on any part of 4th land nor his mother

him I also give to my said son my share of hoggs that I bought at monie's Sallivans store I give & boguath
unto my loving wife frances moore one negro woman named Sarah & all her future increase unto her
her heirs for ever. ~ I divid give & boguath unto my four children Sarah Elizabeth frances & William
old Rachel & young Rachel Comer black both by Quock & all their future increase to be equally di-
vided between my aforesd. several children as they shall severally attain to age or day of marry age
shall first happen. ~ It. I give & boguath unto my son William moore two hundred acres of land and one
hundred whereof being at Tompkins ridge & 1/2 other hundred acres in a swamp at 1/2 broad run vnto
him & his heirs for ever. ~ It. I give & boguath unto my two sons Cason moore & William moore all my land
at Long Island unto them & their heirs for ever to be equally divided between them. ~ It. I give and
boguath unto Lewis Purvins that hundred acres of land I had of him provided he make an acquit-
ance of that land he had of me & save & defend my heirs from all damages or damages that shall or
may accrue by my said deed unto him. but it is my will & my wife is that yd said Lewis Purvins do
hold & posses of yd said two hundred acres of land, 1/2 one hundred he had of me & that hundred I also had of
him only he still saving my heirs from all damages as aforesaid & to stand to what determination
that may be for yd recovering of that hundred acres of land he had of me, & that I do to ban my heirs
from having any right to yd same by this my will. It. I give & boguath unto my loving wife
my four young or children all my horses & mares to be equally divided between them when
they shall severally come to age or day of marry age. It. I give & boguath that 1/2 part of my estate to
be real & personal to be equally divided between my loving wife & four children that is not already
given by this my will. and Lastly I do make & ordain constitute & appoint my loving wife fran-
moore & my loving brother Henry moore Exor^s of this my last will & Testament. In witness where-
