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In the Name of God Amen: this is the day of September in the year of our Lord God on
 thousand seven hundred twenty six I Eason Moors of prince George County do make
 & declare this my last will & Testament in manner & form follow- ing viz: first I do
 commend my Spirit into the hands of almighty God maker & redeemer my body to be
 Interred as my Exors shall think fit & as Touching Temporal Estate my will & Desires is
 manner & form following that is say viz: - I give & bequeath unto my son John
 my plantation whers I now live to him & the heirs of his body lawfully begotten
 for ever; my will & Desires is that my said son noways molesting his mother of
 the housing only building whers he shall thing - I give unto my said son John three
 negroes I own & sary & all their increase when he shall come to age to him & his
 heirs for ever - I give unto my beloved wife Ann four negroes primors son
 Sumaker & sony during her life & after her death to return to my said son John
 they & all their increase for ever: the girl Jenny I give to my beloved wife to he
 and her heirs for ever: I give unto my said son John three brooding mares prin
 rose & a two year old one & all their increase to him & his heirs for ever: - I give to
 my beloved wife Ann five hors for & all their increase to her & her heirs for ever: I
 give unto my said son John one feather bed & furniture when he shall come to
 age to him & his heirs for ever: I give unto my said son John four parsons four dish
 os & a dozen of plates two pots & five pan & large brass Cittels five bowls & twenty
 five pigg & ten barrels of corn & a walnut Table when he shall come to age to him
 & his heirs for ever: I give unto my said son John five pound fifteen shilling in all
 when he shall come of age to him & his heirs for ever; my will & Desires is that my stock
 of cattle & sheep be divided & be Equally divided between my wife & son I give wi
 my said son John all my land & marches at Long Island to him & his heirs for ever: &
 I give unto my beloved wife Ann all that part of my Estate not mentioned to her & her heirs
 over & likewise I do appoint make my beloved wife Ann the bro Henry wood house
 of this my last will & Testament. In witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal of day
