In the Name of God Amen; I Charles Smyth of Newbern, North Carolina, in the County of Prince Georges being in an afflicted State of body but of sound mind & memory do hereby give & Bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret during the State of her wid.hood the Use of all my Lands & Tenements both in Town & Country. It I Give & Bequeath unto my son Tully Smyth (if not to be possessed with the same till after the Expiration of my beloved wife Margaret, her widowhood) my plantation lying on the north looking Road likewise one Acre of Land in Newbern that I purchased from Capt. Bath Dayer (excepting that part of the aforesaid lately sold unto Mr. Tho. Haynes) as also one Negro boy called George, one silver clasped Bible, one prayer book; Every of which I Give unto my son Tully to him & his heirs forever; It I Give unto my son Piers Smyth (first Excepting the Use thereof as above) my plantation of Land & lying in Little Creek, one bible, one prayer book to him & his heirs forever; It I Give & Bequeath unto my three daughters Betty, Margaret & Anne to them & their heirs forever the three Acre where on I now live with houses & Appurtenances, as also one Acre silver Spoon Equally to be devised betwixt my said three daughters. It I Give unto my daughter Betty one silver clasped bible one gilt prayer book to her & her heirs forever. It I Give & Bequeath unto my loving wife Margaret Smyth the following books my large bible, one best prayer book, whole duty of man, a duty already provided saddle & bridle; It all the Remainder of my books not heretofore given, my desire is they be Equally divided between my two sons Tully & Piers; It all the Remainder of my Estate whether within doors or without after the payment of my just debts & not heretofore given I will & Bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret & further my hope & desire is that my beloved wife Margaret & my well respected friends Capt. Bath Dayer take on them as soon as they can see this my last will & Testament accomplished. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this second day of Novem. 1768 one thousand seven hundred & forty nine

have made my last will & Testament in Writing bearing date the second of November 1749. I then  
Charles Smyth by this present edict, do ratify & confirm my said will & Testament & as further give  
& bequeath unto my son Fully Smyth all my house & lands, & my meaning & will is that this Co-  
dict or schedule be adjudged to be apart & parcel of this my last will & Testament. & that all things  
herein contained be fully & truly performed & as fully & as apply in every respect as if the  
same were set down & contained in my said last will & Testament. With life my hand this third  
day of November 1749
