Thus to be my last will & Testament wherunto I have given & bequeathed unto Margaret & Mary Brock my plantation wherof I now live with all priviledges therunto belonging to her & her heirs lawfully begotten of her body: only my loving sister Mary Brock to have her life time in above said plantations but if in case of above named Margaret Brock should die without such heirs as is above named then I said land to go to Mary Brock daughter of & aforesaid James & Mary to her and her heirs lawfully begotten as aforesaid and I have given & bequeathed unto Margaret Brock my bed and furniture belonging to it I have given & bequeathed to my sister Mary Brock one large pot & pot hooks I have given & bequeathed unto Margaret and Mary Brock one small pot & poeace. Item my will is and it is my will that after all my lawfull debts be paid what is left of my Estate be Equally divided between my sister Mary Brock & Margaret Brock & Mary Brock daughter of & aforesaid James & Mary Item after my decease I do appoint my brother in law James Brock & my sister Mary Brock to be my whole & sole Ex^{rs} of this my last will & Testament wherunto I have set my hand & fixed my seal this second Day of October Anno Domini 1716

In the Name of God Amen I Christopher Coch^r of the County of prince George in the Colony of virginia
being very sick and weak but of sound & perfect memory that the beginning is & almighty for I am
feeling to mind of Transitoryness and uncertainty of this mortal life & that it is appointed for all
men once to die have therefore thought fit to make this my last will and Testament in manner
following - I give & bequeath my soul into the hands of almighty God who gave it
hoping that through the merits of my dear Lord Jesus Christ to obtain full pardon & remission
of all my sins & that I shall receive it in a full & true satisfaction & My body to be buried

his said Bond I trust would & should have done & I am I commit & care & tuition of my Daugh^r Eliza
 unto my loving uncle Mr. William Cock until she is marry or shall attain to age of sixteen years under
 same limitation & restrictions and to y^e Intent & purpose as my above said three Daughters are before
 disposed of. I then I give unto my Daughter Ann Cock all my plate & three pair of gold Shurt buttons
 I give & bequeath unto Mr. Anne Furlong all what so ever she has of mine in her possession at this time
 also six barrels of Indian Corn shelled & of one hundred pounds weight of good fat & sweet butter
 to be paid & delivered her at Maj^r Spratts landing by my Ex^r. Item I do give all my land & appurtenances
 at New Town in County aforesaid unto my Daughter Mary Cock & her heirs for ever
 I do also appoint that all y^e rest residue & remainder of my personal Estate of what so ever be
 in or to be appraised by same returned to the Court according to Law by my Ex^r as soon as
 conveniently may be after my decease when it shall please God that my Ex^r have received & paid
 all my debts that y^e surplusage be settled & an acc^t thereof made up & delivered to y^e said Court upon
 oath & y^e balance accruing due to be equally divided between my four Children to whom I give
 y^e said I then I constitute & ordain Cap^t Henry Chapman to be Ex^r of all my wth goods to
 collect & receive y^e same & do hereby give him ten p^{ts} cent reward & salary for his care & pains about
 that affair out of what he shall receive & order that he account wth my other Ex^r concerning y^e said
 collections often as to them it shall seem meet & pay what is received unto them to be disposed of for the
 benefit and advantage of my Children & I then I give unto Mr. Sampson Trevelyan my affectional friend
 amounting to of Twenty shillings value I do also ordain and constitute my loving uncle Mr.
 John Balthusent Maximilian Trevelyan to be Ex^r of this my will to take care of & manage y^e other
 parts of my Estate; which Cap^t Henry Chapman is not appointed to do & I hereby trusting in their faithful
 discharge of that Trust with Integrity do hereby revoke & annul all former wills & declare this
 to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal y^e fifth Day of June
 Anno Domini 1716
