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Then my Will is that the Lands given should be to his  
Brother John Woodhouse and the Negro Wench sold  
and the Money equally divided amongst all his  
Brothers & Sisters. I then Give and Bequeath unto my  
Son Henry Woodhouse one Negro Fellow called Frank  
& one Sorrel Mare called Region. It is my desire that  
my said Son Henry shall take the appraised value  
of one Negro Wench called Judith, one Dishone bed  
chest Bed, One Gun & one pair of Kitchen Fire Dogs  
he paying unto my Daughter Mary Woodhouse  
when she come to age of Marriage the appraised  
value of the Negro Wench Judith. I then Give and  
Bequeath unto my Son John Woodhouse one Negro  
Girl called Tibb one Sorrel Mare and her Mare  
both them & their increase to him and his Heirs  
for ever. I then Give and Bequeath unto my  
Daughter Elizabeth Woodhouse one Negro Girl  
called Sarah to her and her Heirs for ever. I leave  
all the rest of my Estate not already given away  
to be sold and the Money to be apply'd towards  
paying my just debts and the debts of my Husband  
and William Woodhouse deceased, I also consti-  
tute and appoint my Son Henry Woodhouse my  
Executor at this last Will and
