give the said Lands and their Appurtenances unto the
first Male Child that my Daughter Elizabeth Necks
may have, and in case my said Daughter dies without
having a Male Child that then I give the aforementioned
Lands and Premises, unto my Grand Daughter Eliza-
beth Neeling and her Heirs for ever. but in case my Grand-
daughter Elizabeth Neeling should die before she arrives to
Lawful age or marries that then I give the aforementioned ^{and}
Premises unto James Lamount son Edward Lamount

 Negro Girl Sarah, to my Daughter Elizabeth Week during
 her natural life.

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and after her decease, I give the said
Negro Girl Sarah with all her Increase, unto my Gra
Daughter Elizabeth Seeling and her Heirs for ever
Item. I give the Use and Labour of the following Neg
to my Wife during her Life, to wit, Adam, Frank, A
John, Lewis, Sue and Cloe, and after the Decease of m
wife Elizabeth, I give the Use and Labour of the above m
tioned Negroes to my Daughter Elizabeth Weeks during
her Life, and after her decease, I leave the said Negroes t
wit, Adam, Frank, John, Lewis, Sue and Cloe, and the
Increase, to be equally Divided amongst and betwixt the Ch
dren that, that my Daughter may have at her Death, or t
Survivors of them and their Heirs for ever. Item. I give an
bequeath unto my Daughter Elizabeth Weeks the one half o
my Stock of Cattle excepting my Yoke of Steers, to my Wife
with her half of the Cattle, likewise, I give unto my Daugh
ter the one half of my Sheep to her and her Heirs for ever
Item. I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter

with her half of the Cattle, likewise, I give unto my Daugh-
ter the one half of my Sheep to her and her Heirs for ever
Item, I give and bequeath unto my Grand Daughter
Elizabeth Seeling one young Bay Mare, to her and her
Heirs for ever. Item, I give and bequeath unto a Mary
Cook, one Bed and furniture not being the best to her
and her Heirs for ever. The Remainder of my Estate that
I have not already given away. I leave the Use to my Wife
during her life for her Maintenance, and in case she should
be in want for her support, that she sell such part as may
supply her wants. I also Constitute and appoint my
friend John Ackiss, Charles Williamson my beloved Wife
Elizabeth Cannon Executors of this my last Will and
Testament utterly denying all other Wills by me made
as Witnesses my Hand this 8th Day of April
1780.
