the Father of all mercies. I do hereby make and ordain
this my last Will and Testament in manner and
form following. Item I bequeath unto James Murphree a
boy that liv'd with me in the Corv and Earling. One

Man's Saddle, one Saddle with pig and two Shoots.
and all my wearing Goods and if my Sorrel Mare
should be with foal at present that Colt, to him and
his Heirs for ever. Item I give unto my loving wife Eli-
sabeth Ironston all the remaining parts of my Estate
within Doors and without, after my lawfull Debts
and funeral Charges being first paid. during her Wid-
owhood or natural life, and after my loving wifes
Widowhood or decease, shall be my will and desire is
that my Daughter Polly Currant shall have my Estate
as I have left to my wife, to be to her and her Heirs
for ever. and if so be my Daughter Polly Currant
should die without Heir lawfully begotten of her
Body, that then my Will and desire is, the said
James Murphy shall have the whole of my Estate then
remaining to him and his Heirs for ever, and Lastly
I do appoint ^{and ordain} my loving wife Elisabeth Ironston and

I do appoint my loving wife Elisabeth Ironter and
my friend James Smith whole and sole Executors of this
my last Will and Testament annulling all other Wills
