and bequeath to my half Sister Sarah Woodhouse
my Land joining Mr. Aytchison and Lemuel Cor-
rick's a Negro Wench call'd Nan, a boy call'd
Isaac, and a Girl call'd Rachel to be her own
or her Heirs for ever. Item, I will and desire
that all other things so belonging unto me to be
Sold and to discharge my just Debts and after
Discharging my Debts, the remainder of the mo-
ney, to be divided between my half Brother
Thomas Woodhouse and my half Sister Sarah

Item. I Name and appoint James Woodhouse senior
and John Woodhouse son of Jonathan Woodhouse
deceased Solle Executors to this my last Will, and

Will or Wills by me made heretofore In Witness
per Test June 7th 1780.
