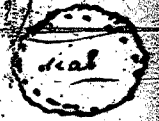


Know all Men by these Presents that I Thomas Kempe am held and firmly bound to Benjamin Harrison Esquire Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the full and just Sum of Five Hundred Pounds to be paid to the said Benjamin Harrison Esquire and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth to which payment well and truly to be made. I bond myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators firmly by these Presents Sealed with my Seal and dated this fourteenth day of March 1782. —

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that Whereas the above bound Thomas Kempe is by the Court of Princess Anne County pursuant to an Act of the last Session of Assembly appointed a Commissioner to receive the Taxes imposed in certain enumerated Commodities, if therefore the said Thomas Kempe do
