ison, ^{Esquire} Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth
of Virginia in the full and just Sum of Five hundred
pounds to be paid to the said Benjamin Harrison
Esquire and his Successors for the use of the said
Common wealth. to which payment well and truly
to be made I bind my self my Heirs Executors and
Administrators firmly by these Presents. Sealed with my
Seal and dated this fourteenth day of March 1782.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such
that Whereas the above bound John Sentine is by
the Court of Princeps County pursuant to an Act of the
last Session of Assembly appointed a Commissioner to
Receive the Taxes imposed on certain enumerated Com-
modities if therefore the said John Sentine do faith-
fully discharge the duties of the said Office of Commissioner
then the above Obligation to be void or else to remain
in full force and Virtue.
