line from thence a South course to a Dogwood on
John Braine line, to him and his Heirs for ever.
I give and bequeath unto Son Morris forty five
Acres of Land more or less. on the westward side of
my Land to him and his Heirs for ever. I do here
by certify my son Morris Hill Edward

by appoint my Son Morris Hill Edward
Brown and Tully Hill my whole Executors
to this my last Will and Testament disannul-
ling and revoking all other Wills by me form-
erly made, In Witness whereof I have hereun-
to set my Hand this twenty fourth day of No-
vember one thousand seven hundred and Eighty
One
