bequeath to my Daughter Ann Clay one Bed
and furniture, one Dish and one Bason and
six plates to her and her Heirs for ever, also one
also three head of Cattle

Sow and six Shoats. ^{also three head of cattle} I give my Daughter Ann,
and her Heirs all the rest of my Estate not mentioned.
I give to my son in Law Jeremiah Berry and to my
Daughter Ann Clay, to be equally divided between
them after my wifes Death. my Will and desire is
that my wife should have the use of the aforementioned
Legacies during her natural life Lastly. I nominate
constitute and appoint my wife Mary Clay and
John Woodard my whole and Sole Executors of this
my last Will and Testament, utterly revoking
and disannulling all Wills and Testaments by me
made, and to the truth I have hereunto set my
Hand and Seal this 3. Day of April 1781.

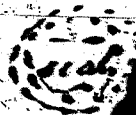
