my Grandson Malachi Williamson and his Heirs for
ever, also give to my wife one best Bed and furniture
one Chest, one Table two Iron potts, one butter pott, two
pewter Dishes, three pewter plates, one Bason three Chairs
one Cow and Heifer, one old Horse, one foot Wheel, one
powdering Tubb, all my Corn and Pork in the House
to her and her Heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to
my son Tully Williamson one Girl named Nancy to
him and his Heirs for ever. I give and bequeath to
my Son Henry one Negro boy named Abel and Negro.

Wench Violet to him and his Heirs for ever. also
Negro Amy after my wifes Death or Intermarring
I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Matthias
Williamson one Negro boy named Will. also one Cow
~~in lieu of five hard Dollars borrowed of his father to~~
~~him and his Heirs for ever.~~ I give and bequeath unto
my Grand Daughter Fervilla Williamson Daughter
of John one Negro boy named Caesar to her and her
Heirs for ever. I give and bequeath unto my Grand
Daughter Lurana Williamson fifteen Pounds hard
money to her and her Heirs for ever. I leave my Negro
Man Matthew to be Sold after my Wifes Death or
Intermarriage, and the Money arising from the Sale
to be divided amongst my Grand Children Thomas
Lodwick, Tully and Christopher and Molly sons and
Daughter of Thomas Williamson dec'd. I leave my
Negro Wench Aliph to be Sold, and all the remainder
of my Estate that is not given away. and after my

Negro Wench Meph to be sold, and all the remainder
of my Estate that is not given away, and after my
just Debts and Legacies paid the remainder to be
equally Divided between my sons Tully Henry and
Francis's Children my son Francis's Children to have
one third part, equally divided amongst them and their
Heirs except one young Negro boy Jemmy. I give to
my son Malachi Williamson and his Heirs on Con-
dition he agrees and let my Wife continue on the plan-
tation and in the Houses she now lives, and to enjoy
the same part and priviledges as I my self have
done, on the contrary I give the said Negro to my
Wife and I do hereby appoint my friend John Achis
my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and
Testament disannulling and revoking all other Wills
by me formerly made. In Witnes whereof I have here-
unto set my Hand and Seal this 5th Day of
February, One thousand seven hundred and Eigh-
ty two. —
