This Indenture

made the first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven and Eighty two between Anthony Walke of the parish of Lynhaven and County of Princeps Anne of the one part and Jonathan Park of the City of Richmond & County of Henrico of the other Witnesseth that the said Anthony walke for and in consideration of the sum of one Hundred pounds Current money of to him in hand paid by the said Jonathan Park of the Receipt whereof the said Anthony Walke doth hereby Acknowledge and therof acquit and discharge the said Jonathan Park He the said Anthony Walke hath granted bargained & sold Aliened and Confirmed & by these presents doth grant Bargain & sell Alien and Confirm unto the said Jonathan Park his heirs & assigns four parcels of Land lying & being at or near Rump's Landing in the aforesaid County of Princeps Anne to wit, Beginning at the South East corner where the Roads fork leading to the Great Bridge the North Landing Rump's Landing and the Bay side & running the following courses & distances South five Degrees West two Hundred and Eighty feet nine Inches from the Corner along the Road that leads to the Great Bridge thence South fifty one Degrees East two Hundred & fifty one feet thence North five Degrees East two Hundred & Eighty feet nine Inches to the Road that leads to the North Landing thence along the said Road North fifty one Degrees West two Hundred & fifty one feet to the first station
