This Indenture made the fourteenth day of October in the year of our Lord, One thousand seven hundred and Ninety six. Between Charles Fisher of the County of Princeps Anne and Commonwealth of Virginia and Anne his wife of the one part; and James Tucker Merchant of the Borough of Norfolk and Commonwealth aforesaid of the other part; Witnesses that the said Charles Fisher and Anne his wife for and in Consideration, of the Sum of Three hundred and forty Pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said James Tucker at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; have granted, bargained sold, aliened, infeoffed, released and confirmed, and by these presents, do grant, bargain sell, alien, infeoff, release and confirm unto the said James Tucker his heirs and Assigns for ever:

All that piece or parcel of Land situate lying and being in Kempsville in the said County of Princeps Anne which Jacob Valentine some time past sold and conveyed to the said Charles Fisher; bounded as in the said Valentines Deed for the same is particularly expressed; all Houses, buildings, Ways, waters, profits, commodities, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever; And the reversion and reversions, remainders and remainders, Rents, Issues and profits thereof; and also all the Estate, right title and Interest of them the said Charles Fisher and Anne his wife, of in and to the same, To have and to hold the aforesaid piece or parcel of Land with its appurtenances situate as aforesaid, unto the said James Tucker his heirs and Assigns forever; to the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Tucker his heirs and Assigns forever. The Commonwealth of Virginia to John Hancock, William White, Thomas Walke, Thomas Lawson, Thomas Wickart Jr and Cornelius Calvert Junr, Gent, Greeting; Whereas Charles Fisher and Nancy his wife by their certain Indenture of Bargain and Sale bearing date the 14th day of October 1796 have Sold and Conveyed unto James Tucker all that piece or parcel of Land lying and being in Kempsville in the County of Princeps Anne which Jacob Valentine some time past sold & Conveyed to the said Charles Fisher bounded as expressed in the said Valentines deed for the same; And Whereas the said Nancy cannot conveniently travel to our Court of our said County to make acknowledgment of the said Conveyance therefore We do give unto you, or any two, or more of you power to receive the acknowledgment which the said Nancy shall be willing to make before you of the Conveyance aforesaid contained in the said Indenture hereunto annexed; and We do therefore Command you, that you do personally get the said Nancy and receive her acknowledgment of the same and examine her privately and apart from the said Charles Fisher her husband whether she doth the same freely and voluntarily without the persuasions or threats of her said Husband and whether she be willing that that the same should be Recorded in our County Court of Princeps Anne, and when you have received her Acknowledgment and examined as aforesaid that you do distinctly and openly testify us thereof under your seals sending them and
