

This Indenture made April the twentieth day in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and two Between John Dawley of County of Prince Anne in the Colony of Virginia in the part and John Wright of County and Colony aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for an consideration of the sum of six pound fifteen shillings lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Wright at the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said William Dawley and Anne his wife acknowledgeth and every part and parcel thereof doth accept release and discharge the said John Wright his heirs executors administrators and assigns for ever hath granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto the said John Wright his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Marsh land lying in the County aforesaid and on the north side of Nanny Creek beginning at the said creek running north east to the back line of the said Dawleys tract taking fifteen acres of Marsh land with houses and profits therefrom and all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of them the said William Dawley and Anne his wife his heirs executors administrators and assigns or either of them of in or on to the same and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances to have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singular the appurtenances hereby granted or intended to be granted unto the said John Wright his heirs executors administrators or assigns to the only proper use and benefit of him the said John Wright his heirs and assigns for ever and the said William Dawley and Anne his wife for themselves their heirs executors administrators and singular the appurtenances
