Colony aforesaid of the other part, Willoughby Whitehurst that for herein  
consideration of the sum of Two hundred pounds lawful money  
of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Edwards at the  
enclasing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said  
Willoughby Whitehurst and Frances his wife acknowledge doth  
pay part and paule thereof doth acquit release and discharge  
the said John Edwards his heirs Executors Administrators and  
Assigns forever hath granted bargained sold and confirmed  
and by the presents doth grant bargain sell and confirm unto  
the said John Edwards his heirs and Assigns forever one undivided  
part or paule of Land lying in the County aforesaid and bound

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as followeth. Beginning at a corner in a bog joining Jeremiah  
Whitehurst's land and running N 6° W 5' thence N 85° W 13' Ch to  
the rode thence S 43° E down the said road thence south 63°  
East down the said road to the Marsh thence running a Northern  
course to a corner bound by the said marsh thence running westward
