hereby granted or intended to be granted with the said John Edwards  
his heirs Executors administrators or Assigns to the only proper use  
and behoof of him the said John Edwards his heirs and Assigns  
forever and the said Willoughby Whitehurst and Francis his wife  
for them selves their heirs Executors administrators doth covenant  
to and with John Edwards his heirs and Assigns the he the
