

Know all Men by these presents that I Joel Peed of Norfolk County, for and in Consideration of the natural love and affection which I have for my two Daughters Dinah and Francis Peed, and for their further advancement in life, have granted, bargained, sold & delivered, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto my daughters Dinah and Francis Peed their heirs & Assigns three Negroes, to wit, Nancy, Phillis and Dinah, two head of Horses, ten head of Cattle & thirty five head of Hogs, with my Household and Kitchen furniture & Plantation utensils, To have and to hold the said three Negroes, Stock & Household furniture unto my two daughters Dinah and Francis Peed their heirs and Assigns forever, to their own proper use & behoof forever, and I do hereby Oblige myself my heirs, Executors & Administrators to warrant and defend the title & estate of the said three Negroes & Furniture to my two said Daughters Dinah and Francis Peed their heirs & Assigns forever against all persons whatsoever, In Witnes whereof, I have hereunto set my hand & Seal this 28th of June 1801

This Indenture made the fifth day of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and one Between Isaac Tolt and Francis his wife of the County of Princeps Anne, and Henry Pallott and Susannah his wife of the Borough of Norfolk of the one part, and Thomas Griffin Coach Maker of said Borough of Norfolk of the other part, Whereas Isaac Tolt late of said County of Princeps Anne deceased was in his lifetime, and at the time of his death seized and possessed in fee simple of certain Tract or parcel of Land situate, lying and being in said County of Princeps Anne where he then resided containing Twenty five Acres more or less according to the ancient, known, and reputed bounds thereof, which he by his last Will and Testament among other things gave and devised to his three Daughters the said Francis and Susannah, and Anne now the wife of James Bishop, being all the Children which he then had, as by said Will duly proved and recorded in the Court of said County of Princeps Anne reference being thereunto had will more fully appear, Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Isaac Tolt and Francis his wife, and Henry Pallott and Susannah his wife, for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and Eighty pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Griffin at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Have, and each of them hath, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released and confirmed, and by these presents do, and each of them doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm unto the said Thomas Griffin his heirs and Assigns forever, all the Estate, right, title, interest claim and demand of them the said Isaac Tolt and Francis his wife and Henry Pallott and Susannah his wife, and each of them
