ginia to him in hand paid the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have
bargained, sold and delivered, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell,
alien and confine unto the aforesaid Margaret Robinson and to her
heirs and assigns forever One certain parcel or tract of Land containing
Eight Acres be the same more or less, lying and being in the aforesaid coun
ty of Prince Anne, being part of that tract of Land wherein the afore
said M^r Margaret Robinson now lives it being a point of Land on the
Eastly part of that tract which is partly surrounded by the Fresh
Woods and adjoining on one part the lands of M^r The Symonds and
divided from his other lands by a line of marked trees according to agreement
of the two parties with all the tenements and appurtenances thereto belonging
to have and to hold the said lands tenements and appurtenances unto
