of two hundred & thirty three dollars and thirty Cents to the said John
Randolph and Lezey his wife in hand paid by the said Southward
Cartwright at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents their receipt
hereon written they do hereby acknowledged they the said John Rando
lph and Lezey his wife have granted bargained and sold aliened and

Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien
and confirm unto the said Southward Cartwright and his heirs
one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the
County of Prince Anne precinct of Blackwater containing
Forty four Acres more or less and bounded as follows to wit, begin
ning at a sweet gum from thence running about west course and
binding on James & Henry Woodard dec. land to a corner beach from
