 Charles James have granted sold and aliened & confirmed & by these presents
 do grant and confirm unto the said Levi Smith his heirs all that tract
 of Land lying James Hangain on the east side and Joseph Walters on the
 south side & joining on the Ruben Doudgys Land containing nine and a
 half Acres and all Houses & appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land
 belonging & all the right title & interest of him the said Charles James and
 the said Charles James his heirs all and singular the premises hereby bargai-
 ned and sold with the appurtenances unto the said Levi Smith his heirs &
 assigns against him and his heirs will forever warrant and defend, he
 the said Charles James have hereunto set his hand and
 affixed his seal the day and year above written.
