This Indenture made this third day of December in
the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one Between
Charles Henry Edward Cannon Jonathan Woodhouse John Wood-
house Commissioners, for selling and dividing the Land, and Neges
belonging to the Estate of William Shephard dec^d, of the County of
Princeps Anne of the one part and Henry Brock of the said
County of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration
of the sum of three pounds four and seven pence current money
of Virginia to the said Charles Henry Edward Cannon Jonathan
Woodhouse John Woodhouse, in hand paid by the said Henry Brock
at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt
whereof we do hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every part thereof
do hereby acquit exonerate and discharge the said Henry Brock
his heirs and Assigns by these presents we the said Commissioners
have granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents
do grant bargain sell, alien and confirm unto the said Henry Brock
his heirs or Assigns one certain piece or parcel of Marsh Land

Containing ten Acres more or less near the old Inlet of Currituck
and is part of the Horse Islands and is the same marsh and land
the dec^d W^m Shephard purchased of James Lovett dec^d and the said James
Lovett dec^d purchased of John Stone dec^d; To have and to hold
the said bargained premises with all the appurtenances therunto
belonging unto the said Henry Brock his heirs and Assigns forever
to his and their own proper use and behoof and the said Charles
Henry Edward Cannon Jonathan Woodhouse John Woodhouse
Commissioners do hereby covenant and promise that the Land is
free from every incumbrance whatsoever had made done committed
or suffered by them the said Commissioners for their selves their
heirs Executors and Administrators the said Bargained premises
unto the said Henry Brock his heirs and Assigns, In Witness
whereof the said Charles Henry Edward Cannon, Jonathan Wood-
house John Woodhouse Commissioners have hereunto set their hands
and Seals the day and year first above written.
