in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one Between
John Garrison and Mary his wife of the County of Prince Anne and
Commonwealth of Virginia of the one part, and Thomas Bonney of
the same place of the other part Witneseth, that the said John Garrison
and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred
and thirty three pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand
paid the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have bargained,
sold and delivered by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, alien, and
confirm unto the aforesaid Thomas Bonney and to his heirs and affigis
forever, one certain parcel or tract of Land containing one hundred and
three Acres and thirty six poles to the same more or less lying and
being in the aforesaid County and in the Neighborhood of Dam Neck
and bounded as follows viz: on the lands belonging to James Moore and
Francis Barnes southerly and westerly and on the lands belonging to
Nathaniel Brock northerly and Moses Brock easterly it being all that
parcel or tract of Land formerly belonging to William Acton and now
to his son an heir Henry Acton with all the tenements and appurtena-
ncies thencunto belonging To have and to hold the said Land tenu-
ments, and appurtenances unto the said Thomas Bonney and to his heirs
and affigis forever to have, possess enjoy and to enter upon the said Land
free and clear from all dowers and incumbrances of what nature or kind
soever and the said John Garrison and Mary his wife their and each of
