 west course in William Stones line to a corner post thence running the
 line between the said S. Stone & Green to the first station, and all houses

 ditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said premises hereby
 granted or any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining and
 the reversion and reversione remainder and remainder into offices and
 profits thereof and also all the Estate right title Interest use trust prop-
 erty claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Joshua Stone
 & Martha Stone of in and to the said premises and all deeds written
 and writing touching or in any wise concerning the same to have
 and to hold the lands hereby conveyed and all and singular other
