of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth
for and that the said Jeremiah MacLannon and Sally MacLannon
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and forty pounds
current Money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Malachi
Williamson at the inscating and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof the said Jeremiah MacLannon and Sally MacLannon acknow
ledgeth and of every part and parcel thereof doth acquit release and
discharge the said Malachi Williamson his heirs Executors Adminis
trators and Assigns forever hath Granted bargained sold and confirmed
unto the said Malachi Williamson his heirs and Assigns forever a cert
ain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and State
aforesaid in Pungo precinct it being the land that the said Jeremiah
MacLannon bought of Solomon Whitchurst whose bounds are as follows
binding Benjamin Capps, Thurogood Lands, Nathan Bonnys and
