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



Chappel, and Tully Moses, in hand paid by the s<sup>r</sup>, Reuben Lovett sen<sup>r</sup>, at  
or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof doth  
humbly acknowledge and thank and of every part thereof doth humbly acquit  
and discharge the said Reuben Lovett his heirs and assigns by  
these presents he the said Thomas Chappel & Tully Moses and wife Mary  
have granted bargained sold alined and confirmed and by these present  
do grant bargain sell aline and confirm unto the s<sup>r</sup>, Reuben Lovett, his  
heirs or assigns, one certain tract or parcel of Land containing thirty three  
acres, the one half of the s<sup>r</sup>, land belonging Thomas Chappel Orphan of Thomas  
Chappel deceased, to whom Tully Moses is Guardian for, and the other half belong-  
ing to Tully Moses and wife Mary, situate lying and being the same Land

that belong'd Thomas Chapple deceased, and adjoining Francis Petty Austin  
Corinto, and the purchaser. To have and to hold the said bargained  
premises with all the appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said  
Reuben Lovett his heirs and assigns forever to his and their own proper  
use and behoof and the said Thomas Chappel orphan and Tully Moses  
and wife Mary, do hereby covenant and promise that the land is free  
from every incumbrance whatsoever had made done committed or suffered  
by them and the said Thomas Chappel orphan Tully Moses and Mary his  
wife for their selves their heirs Executors and Administrators the said  
bargained premises unto the said Reuben Lovett &c<sup>r</sup> his heirs and assigns  
forever will warrant and defend against all and every person or persons  
whatsoever, In Witness whereof we the said Thomas Chappel, Tully  
Moses & Mary his wife have hereunto set their hands and sealed the  
day and year first above written.
