 County of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration
 of the sum of Sixty pounds current money of Virginia to the said Thomas
 Chappel, and Tully Moses, in hand paid by the s^d Reuben Lovett sen^r, at
 or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof we do
 hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every part thereof do hereby acquit
 exonerate and discharge the said Reuben Lovett his heirs and Assigns by
 these presents to the said Thomas Chappel & Tully Moses and wife Mary
 have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents
 do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the s^d Reuben Lovett s^r his
 heirs or Assigns, one certain tract or parcel of Land containing thirty three
 acres, the one half of the s^d land belonging Thomas Chappel Orphan of Thomas
 Chappel dec^d, to whom Tully Moses is Guardian for, and the other half belon-
 ging to Tully Moses and wife Mary, situate lying and being the same Land

that belonged Thomas Chappel dec^d, and adjoining Francis Petty Newen
 Corns, and the purchaser. To have and to hold the said bargained
 premises with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging unto the said
 Reuben Lovett his heirs and Assigns for ever to his and their own proper
