Lord one thousand Eight hundred and two Between Richard Salmons
of the County of Princeps Anne and State of Virginia of the one part and
Caleb Ethridge of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witness
eth that for and in the Consideration of the sum of thirty dollars in hand
paid by the said Caleb Ethridge to the said Richard Salmons the receipt
of he doth hereby acknowledge and therefore doth acquit and discharge the
said Caleb Ethridge and his heirs and have Granted bargained sold and

delivered and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and deliver alien and
confirm unto the said Caleb Ethridge and his heirs a certain tract or
parcel of Land containing five Acres lying in the County of Princeps Anne and
bounded as follows beginning in Newmans patent line on the western side of
the main road joining the Land formerly belonging to John Whithead son of
Jonathan from thence running to the said Newmans patent line in the
Swamp joining the land of John James on the east and joining the land of
the said Caleb Ethridge bought of Molbon Kilgore being all his part of the Land
that formerly belonged to his father Richard Salmons dec. and sold to the said
Richard Salmons by the death of his father. To have and to hold the
