by their certain Deed of bargain & Sale bearing date the 16 day of February
1802, Have sold and conveyed to Joseph Williamson the See Temple Estate
& land in a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Princeps
Anne containing by Estimation Seventy Acres more or less, and whereas the said

Anne cannot conveniently travel to our Court of our County of Princeps Anne
