Wife during her natural life, and after her decease to be equally divided
amongst all my Children, In consequence of the above bequest my wife is
to keep maintain, educate and bring my Children up in a Christian way;
as by reference to said will, will more fully appear. And whereas the said Eliza-
beth Kaynes wife of the s^r James Kaynes on her arrival to the age of twenty one
years, and on her day of Marriage by the aforesaid Will, was entitled to have
and receive her part or proportion of the Slaves whom her father did posses-
sion of, and of the issue or increase of them since the time of his death, And
Whereas Francis Kaynes and Henry Kaynes Children of the said Henry
Kaynes are, are both dead, each of whom it is alleged had a vested interest
in the Slaves of their said father, but their right of possession was by the said will
dependent until they would severally arrive to the age of twenty one, or should be
married, and whereas the said Francis would not, (if living) be twenty one
until the 15 day of December in the year Eighteen hundred & three; and the said
Henry Kaynes if living, would not be twenty one until the 28th March in the year
Eighteen hundred and five, at which periods their several parts or proportions
of the aforesaid Slaves would be divisible, between the s^r Betty Kaynes their
Mother, the s^r Elizabeth Kaynes (wife of the s^r James Kaynes) their Sister of the
whole blood, and the s^r Mary Moore (wife of the s^r Francis Moore) their sister of
the half blood according to the Statute of distributions, and the Law of descent
And Whereas the said Betty Kaynes, and the said James Kaynes, for them-
selves and in behalf of his wife Elizabeth, and the said Francis Moore for him-
self and in behalf of his wife Mary, have agreed that as the s^r Elizabeth's
part or proportion of s^r Slaves might now to be set apart to her, they are willing
and desirous that a division of the s^r Francis Kaynes's and Henry Kaynes
parts or proportions should at the same time be made between and amongst them

according to the rights of each of them, under the before mentioned Laws and
for that purpose they have mutually chosen Thomas Lawson, James Robinson
Dennis Dawley and Peter Whitehurst Gentlemen to make such division
after they have ascertained and set apart to the said Betty Kaynes one third
part to her to be held during her life under the will of her Husband, and
the s^r James Kaynes's & Elizabeth's part in right of the s^r Elizabeth given
to her as herein before mentioned, Now Know ye, that the said Betty Kaynes
James Kaynes for himself and in behalf of his said wife, and the s^r Francis
Moore for himself and in behalf of his said Wife, do covenant, promise and
agree each with the other and for their, and each of their Heirs, Executors and
Administrators that they will stand to, abide by and perform the award of
the said Arbitrators in the allotment, distribution and division the aforesaid
said Slaves; and do consent that such their award shall with this agreement
be entered of Record in the Court of this County, and that the same shall be deemed
and taken as valid and binding on them their Heirs and Assigns forever, as
fully to all intents and purposes, as if the periods at which the s^r Francis and
Henry would have been twenty one years old had already arrived, In Witness
whereof they the s^r Betty Kaynes, James Kaynes & Francis Moore have hereunto
set their Hands & seals the day and Year first herein written
