This Indenture made the third day of May in the Year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and two Between William Kanock of  
the County of Princeps Anne in the Commonwealth of Virginia of the one  
part, and Simon Kanock of the County and Commonwealth aforesaid of  
the other part Witnesseth that the said William Kanock for and in consid-  
eration of four hundred & ten dollars current money of the said Commonwealth,  
to him in hand paid by the said Simon Kanock at or before the sealing and

delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,  
bargained, sold, aliened enfeoffed, released and confirmed, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release and confirm unto the said Simon Kan-  
cock his heirs and Assigns for ever, a certain tract or parcel of land situate, lying  
and being in the County of Princeps Anne and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning  
at a standing white Oak on the road side leading to the Bay being a corner of John  
Kancocks land, thence running and binding on S<sup>d</sup> Road S<sup>W</sup> 1/4 W<sup>th</sup> their chain and  
seventy links, S<sup>W</sup> 1/4 W<sup>th</sup> two chain to a Sycamore at the head of an old Ditch, thence  
binding on a line of marked trees (dividing this land from the said William Kan-  
cocks land) north twenty four degrees west to Richard Lawsons land, thence  
north easterly binding on said Lawsons line to a Gum a corner line of the aforesaid  
John Kancocks, thence binding on S<sup>d</sup> Kanock S<sup>W</sup> 1/4 W<sup>th</sup> chain to a white Oak,  
S<sup>W</sup> 1/4 W<sup>th</sup> two Chain and seventy links to a corner of an old ditch, thence S<sup>E</sup> 1/4 W<sup>th</sup> chain  
and seventy links to the standing Oak first mentioned, containing Really  
one Acre to the same more or less, and all Houses, buildings, Orchards, way, water  
wells, courses, profits, commodities and Appurtenances, also the reversion and  
reversions, remainder and remainders, Rents Issues and Profits thereof, and  
also all the Estate right, title and interest of him the said William Kanock  
of in and to the same, To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land  
situate as aforesaid with its appurtenances unto the said Simon Kanock and  
of his heirs and Assigns for ever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said  
Simon Kanock and of his heirs and Assigns forever, and the said William  
Kanock for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators, doth covenant,
