This Indenture made the eighteenth day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two Between Mary
Hendley wife of James Hendley of the County of Prince Anne in Virginia
of the one part and Hinner Collins of the same County in Virginia of the
other part, Witnesseth that for and in the consideration of the sum of
thirty seven pound ten shillings to her the said Mary Hendley the wife of
James Hendley in hand paid by the said Hinner Collins at or before the
sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Mary
Hendley doth hereby acknowledge and thereupon doth quit release and discharge
her the said Hinner Collins Executors Administrators by these presents the
said Mary Hendley doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said
Hinner Collins in Blackwater out of the patton of Joshua West & Peter
Hartlett due Beginning at a corner white Oak eyning John Simmonstan
thence running along aline old marked tree about west to a corner tree a
pine eyning Samuel Weston land thence along aline of old marked trees
of the said Weston thence across the said land by a line of new marked
trees to Frederick Thompsons land then down aline about south east to
the beginning justly containing thury seven half acres more or less and
all houses buildings orchards woods waters water courses profits commodities
humblements and appurtenances whatsoever and the revision & revisions
remained and unremained rents issues and profits thereof and also all
the estate right title interest use trust property claim or demand whatever
is of her the said Mary Hendley of her and to the said bargained premises and all duds

Evidences and writing touching or in any wise concerning the same to have
and to hold the lands hereby conveyed and all and singular other the
premises hereby conveyed and sold and every part and parcel thereof with
their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Hinner Collins his
hers and assigns for ever to the only proper use and behoef of him the said
Hinner Collins his hers and assigns forever and the said Mary Hendley further
by her heirs executors & administrators doth covenant promise and grant
to and with the said Hinner Collins his hers and assigns by these presents that
the said premises now at the time of sealing and delivering of these presents
is seized of a good sure proper right and title of inheritance in simple
and in the premises hereby bargained and sold and that she has good power
or lawful and absolute authority to grant & convey the same unto the said
Hinner Collins in manner and form aforesaid and that the premises now
are and so farre hereafter shall remaine free and clear of and from all
former gifts grants bargains sales devers rights and title of dowers judge
ments executions tithes troubles charges and incumbrances whatsoever made
done committed by the said Mary Hendley her heirs and all and every singular
other the premises hereby bargained & sold with the appurtenances unto the said Hinner
Collins and his hers and every person or persons whatsoever shall warrant and
