the one part & Jonathan Hopkins of the same place of the other part,
Witnesseth that the said Willoughby Whitchurst for & in consideration
of the sum of Sixty pounds current money of Virginia to him in hand
paid by the said Jonathan Hopkins at or before the sealing and deliv-
ering of these presents the receipt whereof he the said Willoughby Whitchurst
do hereby acknowledge & therefore doth release acquit & discharge him the said
Jonathan Hopkins his heirs executors & administrators by these presents
he the said Willoughby Whitchurst have granted bargained & sold aliened
& confirmed & by these presents do grant bargain & sell alien & confirm unto
the said Jonathan Hopkins this his for ever one certain piece or parcel of
Land containing six acres to be the same more or less bounded as follow-
eth Vizt beginning at a red Oak adjoining the said Jonathan Hopkins
land on the northward corner & running northward binding Ch. Whitchurst

Land about two hundred yards thence running eastward about three hundred
or yards to the said Jonathan Hopkins land thence running westward
joining the said Jonathan Hopkins to the beginning oak & also two Acres adjoining the
eastward corner of the said Jonathan Hopkins land beginning at a sassafras
running eastward a cross the road leading from the great Bridge to Hamp-
