 I do hereby acknowledge I the said John Weston have granted bargained
 and sold aliened confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell alien and confirm unto the S^r Archer Davis and his heirs one certain
 tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Princeps
 Anne precinct of Black water containing Forty Acres more or less, Beginning
 at a red oak upon the river prison thence north to a branch thence south ten
 oak thence west to a water oak thence south to a pine by a branch thence
 west along said Branch saphras thence south to a pine a corner tree
 of the widow Morningsons thence south to a pine thence south to a water oak
 thence north to a water oak thence north to a corner white Oak thence north
 to the aforesaid pine a corner of Morningsons thence North to a white Oak thence
 north to a pine thence north to a shrub Oak by the prison thence various corners
 of the prison to the beginning, and all building ways waters water courses
 profits commodities hereditaments appurtenances whatsoever to the said pre-
 mises belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversion
 remainder and remainders rents Issues and profits thereon and all the estate
 right and title of and I the said John Weston of in and to the same To have

 the premises hereby bargained and sold with the appurtenances unto the said
 Archer Davis his heirs and assigns against him the said John Weston his
