delivery of these presents the receipt whereof, he doth hereby acknowledge, and  
thence and of every part thereof, release, exonerate, acquit and discharge the  
said Stephen Cason his heirs Executors and administrators, Have granted  
bargained sold, alined, transferred and confirmed, and by these presents  
do grant bargain, sell, alien transfer, and confirm unto the said Stephen  
Cason, one certain tract, Plantation, or parcel of land, situate, lying and  
being in said County of Prince's Ann, and containing one hundred acres  
and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a little bridge, at the corner
