sideration of the sum of one hundred, and fifty pounds, by the said Stephen
Cason to the said Willis Butt, in hand paid at and before the sealing &
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof, he doth hereby acknowledge, and
thereof and of every part thereof, release, exonerate, acquit and discharge the
said Stephen Cason his heirs Executors and administrators, Have granted
bargained sold, aliened, transferred and confirmed, and by these presents
do grant bargain, sell, alien transfer, and confirm unto the said Stephen
Cason, one certain tract, plantation, or parcel of land, situate, lying and
being in said County of Prince Anne, and containing one hundred Acre
and bounded as follows to wit, Beginning at a little bridge, at the corner
of Thomas Simmons's field fence, lying on Capt. Bradrick Boush's
land, and running by a line of marked trees eighty two degrees south by
a line West to old Thomas Vial's line, thence along said Vial's line North one
hundred and twenty five yards to Charles Griggs's land, thence running east
wardly a straight course along said Griggs's land to the main road leading
from Humphreys hill to the North Landing, thence along the said road to the
first station, being part and parcel of the tract and plantation of land
which the said Willis Butt purchased of Samuel Vial late of the same County
