This Indenture made this fourth day of September in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two Between Sam^l
Simmons and Mary his wife & Francis Kenley all of the County of Prin-
ce Anne & Commonwealth of Virginia of the one part, and John Bidelle
of the same place of the other part Witnesseth; that whereas Sam^l Sim-
mons and Mary his wife and Francis Kenley for and in consideration of
the sum of one thousand Dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt whereof
they and each of them do hereby acknowledge, have bargained, sold, delivered
and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell alien and confirm unto the
aforesaid John Bidelle his heirs and assigns for ever one certain parcel
or tract of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Prince Anne and
bounded as follows, viz^t on the North by the City's, on the west by the Banks's, on
the South by Charles Kenley son, & on the east by the Bushy's, it being two thirds
of the tract of land formerly held by William Kenley dec^d, and containing by
estimation one hundred and eighteen acres & two thirds to the same more or less,
it being all this proportionable dividend, right and title to the land and plan-
tation aforesaid, with all the tenements and appurtinances unto the same be-
longing To have and to hold the said lands tenements and appur-
tinances unto the aforesaid John Bidelle and to his heirs & assigns for ever,
to take, possess, enjoy, and to enter upon the said Land free and clear from all
debts and encumbrances from either of us the aforesaid Sam^l Simmons, Mary
his wife and Francis Kenley, or one, or either of our heirs or assigns for ever, and
we the aforesaid Sam^l Simmons & Mary his wife & Francis Kenley do hereby
agree, both for ourselves, our, each of our heirs and assigns for ever, to quit all
claim right and title of the aforesaid bargained Premises unto the aforesaid
