

This Indenture made the first day of September, One thousand eight hundred & two, Betwixt William Morris Junr, and Sally his wife of Prince Anne County State of Virginia of the one part, and Jesse Morris of the same place of the part, Witnesseth, that the said William Morris and Sally his wife in consideration of Five hundred & thirty pounds of lawful money of this Commonwealth, to them in hand paid by the said Jesse Morris at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do, and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Jesse Morris his heirs and assigns a certain Tract of Land & Marsh containing one hundred and five Acres more or less, lying and being in the County of Prince Anne, Bound by back bay on the East & North, and adjoining the land of William Dawley on the west, and the land of the said Jesse Morris on the south, it being known by the old plantation together with all the singular houses barns buildings Orchards lands tenements pastures woods ways waters, water courses, privileges profits commodities, advantages, emoluments, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land belonging, or appertaining or with the same used or enjoyed, or reputed, or known as part parcel or member thereof, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of way part and parcel thereof, To have and to hold the said Land & Marsh with the tenements hereditaments and all and singular other things the Premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained

and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Jesse Morris his heirs and assigns for ever, to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jesse Morris his heirs and assigns for ever and the said William Morris and Sally his wife for themselves and their heirs the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Jesse Morris his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claim of them the said William Morris and Sally his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons what soever shall will and do Warrant and for ever Depend by these presents, In Witness whereof the said William Morris and Sally his wife have hereunto set their Hand and Seals the day and year first above written.
