John Watters in hand paid by the said Priscilla Shipp the receipt whereof
he doth hereby acknowledge, & thereof doth acquit the said Priscilla Shipp her
hers &c Administrators by these presents he, the said John Watters have grant-
ed, sold, aliened, & confirmed, & by these presents do grant and confirm unto
the said Priscilla Shipp & her heirs one and a half Acre of Land beginning at
the foot of a ditch, near the road running to the North along the said ditch
until it strikes the land formerly the property of Tully Shipp & son, on the west
side of the tract of land belonging to the said John Watters and all Houses
whatsoever to the said premises belonging & all the right, title, & interest of
them the said John Watters his heirs all and singular the premises hereby
bargained are sold with the appurtenances unto the said Priscilla Shipp

Blanny his wife of the County of Prince Anne of the one part and John
Hopkins of the same County of the other part witnesseth that for and
in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to the said William Hunter
& Blanny his wife in hand paid by the said John Hopkins at or before the date
and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof written they do hereby acknowledge
and thereof doth release acquit and discharge the said John Hopkins his heirs
Administrators by these presents they the said William Hunter and Blanny
his wife have granted, bargained, sold, aliened and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant, bargain, sell, alien and confirm unto the said John Hopkins and
his heirs for ever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in
the County of Prince Anne containing Forty Acres be the same more or less
bounded as followeth Beginning at Peter Whitehurst's line and running along
