John Watters in hand paid by the said Pruitly Shipp the receipt whereof
he doth hereby acknowledge, & thereof doth acquit the said Pruitly Shipp her
heirs &c, Administrators by these presents he, the said John Watters have gran-
ted, sold, aliened, conveyed, & by these presents do grant and confirm unto
the said Pruitly Shipp & her heirs one an a half Acres of Land, beginning at
the foot of a ditch, near the road running to the North along the said ditch
until it strikes the land formerly the property of Tully Shipp &c, on the west
side of the Tract of land belonging to the said John Watters and all Houses
whatsoever to the said premises belonging & all the right, title, & interest of
them the said John Watters his heirs all and singular the premises hereby
bargained and sold with the appurtenances unto the said Pruitly Shipp

Blanny his wife of the County of Princeps Anne of the one part and John
Hopkins of the same County of the other part, Witnesseth that for and
in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to the said William Hunter
& Blanny his wife in hand paid by the said John Hopkins at or before the making
and delivering of these presents the receipt hereof written they do hereby acknowledge
and thereof doth release acquit and discharge the said John Hopkins his heirs and
administrators by these presents they the said William Hunter and Blanny
his wife have granted bargained sold alien and conveyed and by these presents
doth grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said John Hopkins and
his heirs for ever one certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in
the County of Princeps Anne containing Forty Acres be the same more or less
bounded as followeth Beginning at Peter Whitehurst's line and running along
his line down to John Hopkins line thence along his line down to John Hunter line
thence along his line to Peter Whitehurst's line to its first beginning and all houses
building orchards ways coates water courses profits commodities hereditaments and
appurtenances whatever to the said premises hereby granted or any part thereof
belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions, remainder
and remainders with the issues and profits thereof and also all the estate, right, title
interest use trust property claim and demand whatever of the said William
Hunter & Blanny his wife of or unto the premises with the appurtenances
to have and to hold the said forty Acres of Land to the same more or less
with the appurtenances and every parcel thereof to the said John Hopkins his heirs
