in the said indenture of bargain and sale within specified and that she was  
willing the same should be recorded in the Court of the County of Prince  
George to which Court we do hereby certify under our hands & seals this sixth  
day of December 1802.

This Indenture made this twenty-eighth day of July in the year of our  
Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven, Between Joseph Valentine  
and Peggy his wife of the County of Prince George and Commonwealth  
of Virginia of the one part and Neil Jamison of the County and Common  
wealth aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Joseph Valentine  
and Peggy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & fifty  
pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid, by the said Neil Jamison  
at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they  
hereby acknowledge doth release and discharge the said Neil Jamison his  
ministers and administrators, hath granted, bargained sold aliened released and  
unbound and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and discharge  
with the said Neil Jamison his heirs and assigns forever, our certain lot or  
parcel of land situate at Ramps ville containing fourteen thousand five hundred  
and six square rods adjoining the lots James Heathwaite and John Moseley etc.

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and bounded as followeth (viz) beginning at a south east corner stone  
running north eighty one shillings degrees west fifty seven half feet to Braithwaite  
south east corner thence along Braithwaite's line N. seventeen and half degrees  
one hundred & thirty five feet thence N. eighty one shillings degrees W. one hundred &  
one foot to the main street thence along the S. street N. twenty one D. E. eight ten  
half feet to John Moseley's line thence S. fifty nine D. E. two hundred & three feet  
to a corner stone and from thence to the beginning to have and to hold  
the said bargained premises unto the said Neil Jamison and his heirs and  
grantee to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Neil Jamison his he  
irs & assigns forever with all profits commodities and incidentals whatsoever  
that the said Joseph Valentine and Peggy his wife doth for themselves their heirs and  
administrators and assigns covenant promise and grant that they will for ever  
defend and defend the said land against every claim or claims who  
soever witness whereof the said Joseph Valentine and Peggy his wife hath in  
set their hands and seals this twenty-eighth day of July one thousand seven hundred  
and eighty seven
