tine and Peggy his wife of the County of Prince Anne and Commonwealth
of Virginia of the one part and Neil Jamison of the County and Common-
wealth aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Josiah Valentine
and Peggy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred & fifty
pounds current money of Virginia to them in hand paid, by the said Neil Jam-
ison at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they
hereby acknowledge doth release acquit and discharge the said Neil Jamison his
executors and administrators, hath granted, bargained sold aliened released and
conferred and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm
with the said Neil Jamison his heirs and assigns forever, one certain lot or
parcel of Land situate at Kempsville containing fourteen thousand five hundred
and six square feet adjoining the Lot James Heathwaite and John Mosely do,

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and bounded as followeth (viz.) beginning at a south east corner stone is
running north eighty one half degrees west fifty seven half feet to Brathwaite
south east corner thence along Brathwaite line N. seventeen and half degrees to
one hundred thirty five feet thence S. eighty one half degrees to one hundred thirty
