other part Witnesseth that for the consideration of the sum of twenty five
pounds current money of Virginia to the said Anne Batten & Adam Lovell
in hand paid by the said Adam Robinson at and before the sealing &
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge and
through of every part thereof do hereby acquit exonerate and discharge the
said Adam Robinson his heirs & assigns by these Presents, they the said
Anne Batten & Adam Lovell have granted bargained sold aliened and
confermed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confermed unto

the said Adam Robinson his heirs & assigns one certain tract or parcel of
Land situate lying & being in the said County and is the same land sold
by Mrs. Flanckin & Jean his wife to Anthony Lovell as by deed in the part
of said County bearing date the fourth day of May 1775 with appurtenances
containing by estimation Ninety Acres more or less, to have and to hold the
said bargained premises with all the appurtenances therunto belonging
to the said Adam Robinson his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns
for ever to his & their own proper use & behoof and the said Anne Batten &
Adam Lovell do hereby covenant & promise that the said land is free from
every incumbrance whatsoever had made done committed or suffered by
them & the said Anne Batten & Adam Lovell for themselves their heirs Executors
administrators the said bargained premises unto the said Adam Robinson
his heirs Executors or Administrators for ever well warrant and defend against
all every person or persons whatsoever, The Witnesses whereof the said Anne
Batten & Adam Lovell have hereunto set their hands & Seals the day and year
first above written
