

This Indenture made the 3 day of Decembe in the year  
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and two Between Dennis  
Capps and Tabby his wife of the County of Princeps Anne in Virginia  
of the one part & David Dawley of the same place of the other part  
Witnesseth that for sin consideration of the sum of fifty seven pounds  
given to the s<sup>d</sup> Dennis Capps & wife in hand paid by the said David  
Dawley at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt  
whereof they doth hereby acknowledge they the said Dennis Capps & wife  
have granted bargained & sold & confirmed unto the said David Dawley  
his heirs & assigns a certain tract of land containing by estimation forty one and  
shaly be the same more or less lying and being in Muddy Creek in begin-  
ning at a corner sweet gum in David Dawleys line running west  
course in John Capps s<sup>d</sup> line by a parcel of marked trees to a corner hollow  
adjoining on Hillary Moores land from thence turning & running near south  
west course to a corner gum in the line adjoining on William Drouge  
land from thence turning & running near south east course to a sapling  
post and from thence turning and running near a north course to the  
first station adjoining on the s<sup>d</sup> David Dawleys land the s<sup>d</sup> land  
being the land the s<sup>d</sup> Dennis Capps purchased of William Flanagan  
together with all houses Orchards ways water water courses profits & appur-  
tenances whatsoever to the premises belonging or in any wise appertaining  
with the reversions and remainders & remainders rents Issues and  
profits thereof and all the Estate right and title of him the said Dennis  
Capps & wife of in and to the same to have & to hold all & singular

the premises hereby bargained & sold with the appurtenances unto  
the s<sup>d</sup> David Dawley his heirs and assigns to the only proper use  
and behoof of him the said David Dawley his heirs and assigns  
for ever free & clear of and from all doves and all other incumbrances  
of what nature or kind soever and lastly the said Dennis Capps &  
wife all & singular the premises hereby bargained & sold with the appurte-  
nances unto the said David Dawley his heirs all & every other person  
or persons shall and will Warrant and for ever defend these presents  
In Witness whereof they the said Dennis Capps & Wife have here  
unto set their hands and affixed their Seals the day and Year first above  
mentioned
