This Indenture made the fourth day of December one thousand
eight hundred and two, Between Joshua James and Frances his
wife of the County of Prince Anne in Virginia of the one part & John
Munden of same place of the other part witnesseth that for sum consider-
ation of the sum of thirty nine pounds given to the said Joshua James and
wife in hand paid by the said John Munden at or before the sealing of this
of these presents the receipt whereof they doth hereby acknowledge they the said
Joshua James & wife have granted bargained & sold & confirmed unto the said John
Munden his heirs a certain tract of land containing by estimation three

acres one quarter more or less lying and being on Brushy Ridge near
Creek, Beginning at a corner post in Joseph Gwin's line joining Morris Cap-
pe's, Orphans land running easterly course by a parcel of marked trees to an
post in John Fagles line from thence turning and running northerly various
courses to a corner chimney joining on Joseph Wattis son of John Wattis & July
Dodge Orphans land from thence turning running Northwesterly course to the
public road joining the said Reuben Dodge's land from thence turning and
running a Southwesterly course to a pine stump from thence running the same
course still by the line trees as the road goes joining on the said Morris Cap-
pe's, Orphans land to the first station post the said land being tract land that
