 that the said James Tucker and Anne his wife for and in consideration of
 the sum of two hundred and ten pounds to them in hand paid by the said
 Caleb Boush at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged Have granted bargain sold alien and confirm
 and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm
 unto the said Caleb Boush his heirs and Assigns forever, all that piece
 or parcel of Land situate lying and being in Newmarket in the aforesaid County
 of Prince Anne which Jacob Valentini some time past sold and conveyed
 to Charles Fisher and by the said Charles Fisher to the said James Tucker

and bounded as in the said Valentini's deed or conveyance for the same is par-
 ticularly expressed as well fully appear by the records of the Court of the aforesaid
 County, reference being thereunto had, and all Houses, woods, ways, waters,
 profits commodities hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever, and the
 reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders rents issues and profits
 thereof, and also all the estate right title and interest of them the said James
 Tucker and Anne his wife of in and to the same To have and to hold the
 aforesaid piece or parcel of Land with its appurtenances situate as aforesaid
 unto the said Caleb Boush his heirs and assigns for ever to the only proper
 use and behoof of him the said Caleb Boush his heirs and assigns for ever,
 and of the said James Tucker all and singular the premises hereby bargained
 and sold with the appurtenances unto the said Caleb Boush his heirs and
 Assigns shall and well warrant and forever defend against the lawful
 claim of me and my heirs and all and every other person or persons what-
